"escape room" into the classroom in a curriculum related way.



Students rotated through five stations to answer questions that were related to the learning objectives of the lesson on classification system of living things. The answers to the questions were then decoded into the lock codes for the box. After the students rotated through all five stations, they were given time to collaborate as a class and use the codes they found to unlock the locks on the box. The large box had four different locks on it. After all four were unlocked, a clue and a smaller box was revealed. That clue led students to a key that unlocked the smaller box.



Only one class successfully broke into the smallest box and revealed their class prize. The Breakout EDU Kit includes a series of locks, an invisible ink pen, a UV flashlight, and two lock boxes. Using the box, students applied their knowledge and engaged in collaboration as they competed in problem solving within their small groups. Congratulations to the first BREAKOUT BOX WINNERS!



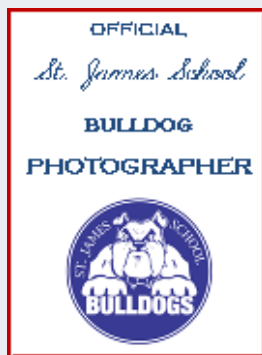
**Taffy Apple Sale**
