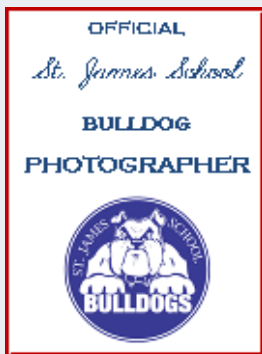



### Curriculum Corner-Technology

Eighth graders at St. James School have been participating in an "Introduction to Coding Unit" through Code.org this month. This unit is a blend of "unplugged lessons" and self-paced puzzles that students work through on the Code.org website. Unplugged lessons allow students to step away from the computer in order to use hands-on materials to learn the logic behind new coding skills. Our first unplugged lesson, *Graph Paper Programming*, asked students to write an algorithm for their partner to use to color a specific pattern on a piece of graph paper. The image below gives an example of a pattern on graph paper accompanied by its algorithm.

Follow along with your finger and see if you can figure out how to get this image from the program to the right.

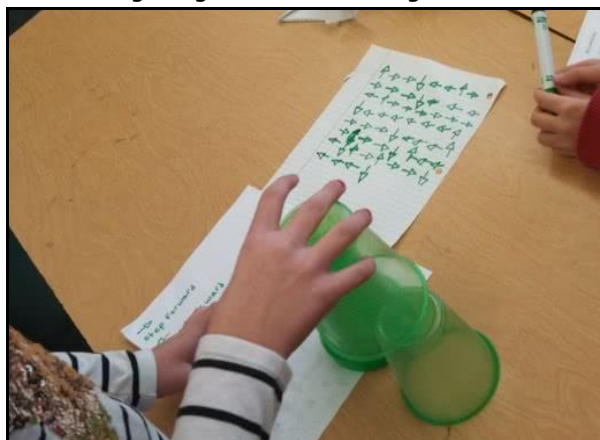
Now, our entire program looks like this:

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Our most recent unplugged lesson, *My Robotic Friends*, asked students to work together to write an algorithm for a "robot" (a.k.a. their teammate) to use to stack cups into a pyramid formation. The picture below shows a "robot" reading an algorithm and stacking cups accordingly. The teachers, Miss Kenny and Miss Harter, along with the eighth graders are having a lot of fun with this unit!





## Counselor's Corner- Mrs. McGowan, School Counselor

Did you know that every morning at St. James School, after the Pledge of Allegiance and daily prayer, the students and staff recite our motto, "At St. James School we follow in the footsteps of Christ by being Caring, Helpful, Respectful, Self-Disciplined and Trustworthy."?

I think most of us know what it means to be caring and helpful, but this year I wanted to start off with a focus on *respect*. What does it look like at school and at home? What does it sound like at home and school? We discussed being kind to one another, including each other, listening to one another. We talked about manners. How can we use our manners in the cafeteria? How can we be most respectful to Jesus at Mass?

Our fifth graders participated in their first retreat 'Letting Your Light Shine' this week. The retreat focused on the light of Christ in our life and how that light shines in our relationship with ourselves, others, and God. Jesus asks us to be a light for all people. We each need to make sure that we do not let our light fade. We also need to help and challenge one another to shine brightly. Again, we circle back to the concept of *respect*.

We will watch, notice, and encourage our students as they demonstrate *respect*.

**Athletics**

**Academic Eligibility**

Students in grades 5-8 and their families are reminded about athletic eligibility.

**ELIGIBILITY FOR EXTRACURRICULAR ACTIVITIES**

- To maintain eligibility, a student must maintain an overall average of 77% or above in every class; otherwise, the student will be unable to participate in sports and/or extra-curricular activities for five school days. This period will include activities on a weekend within the five school day period
- Grades will be checked for eligibility biweekly from the start of the season/activity on Tuesdays. Eligibility will be reported to students, parents, coaches and other adult leaders of activities on Wednesdays. Ineligibility periods begin on Thursdays. Students and parents should monitor student grades on PowerSchool
- A student must be present for at least half a day of school to participate in extra-curricular activities that evening. This includes all sports, clubs, dances, performances, rehearsals and practices

Please remember that informing student and families about ineligibility isn't pleasant for anyone! With PowerSchool available 24/7, "I didn't know" is not an excuse.
