

UGH!

WHAT: "UPPER GRADE HOMEWORK" completion or "UGH!" is a mandatory, lunch time homework detention for students who are missing homework assignments. This program will give students time to complete these missing assignments.

WHEN: Tuesday and Friday during the Upper grade lunch period from 12:15-12:45 pm.

WHERE: Computer Lab-Students will Come and check in with the "UGH!" supervisor. Students who bring cold lunch will immediately begin their assignment and eating their lunch. If a student is eating a Hot Lunch, they will be given an opportunity to go get their lunch (**after checking in**) and then they will return to the computer lab to eat their lunch and complete their assignment. Students will eat their lunch while silently working on their assignments. An allergy free table will be available.

THIS IS NOT TUTORING! If a student needs teacher assistance to complete the assignment they MUST arrange a time to meet with their teacher for clarification! "UGH!" supervisors only monitor student attendance.

WHY: Teachers have observed behaviors regarding inconsistent homework completion. We have developed the "UGH" program in order to proactively assist our students in developing the good homework habits necessary for success in high school.

HOW: Teachers will give a student a verbal or written reminder to turn in the missing homework assignment. The student is then given an additional 3 days to turn in the missing assignment. If the assignment is not turned in during the 3 day "grace period," **before 8:45 am**, the student will receive an "UGH!" slip. **If the late work is turned in after 8:45 am, the student is still required to attend UGH.** These "UGH!" slips will be given to the student the day that they must report to "UGH!" to complete their homework assignment for half credit. **The UGH slip must be returned with a parent/guardian signature the following day after attending UGH.**

Students must bring their assignment with them. If they are not prepared they will be assigned for the next "UGH" day however, they will not be allowed to leave the computer lab.

If a student does not show up for their assigned day they will receive a Citation.

If a student is referred more than a total of 6 times during the same trimester by the same teacher, a parent conference with student attendance is required.
