

School Uniform Code 2018-2019

Notes on uniform...

- Girls in Grade 6-8 may wear a navy blue shirt (with or without logo) that is worn with the plaid skirt (**no higher than 2 inches above the knee**)
- Should the child chose to wear navy blue pants, they must be in accordance with the pants code and a white (for girls) or light blue (for boys) polo shirt is worn
- Sweaters should be navy blue without hoods

Although the retail world makes this a bit challenging, shoes **must be predominately one neutral color (black, blue, white, brown, tan) and worn** with white or navy blue socks. Solid “Bulldog blue” is also acceptable for shoes. Shoe laces should be the primary color of the shoe. **Sandals, Converse (Chuck Taylors), and backless shoes are not permitted.**

The reality is that shoes can be a distraction in school. Once of the objectives for our school uniform is to remove that distraction. Your compliance with the uniform guidelines is appreciated!
