Check Out What We're Doing.

Religion- We discussed the importance of prayer in our daily life. Students discovered that they can use their 5 fingers to help them pray. We also focused on the importance of showing thanks for all the blessings we receive. We discussed ways that we can thank God for these gifts.

Reading – We read the book Poppleton to work on analyzing a character, Evidence from the text was used to develop ideas about the main character. Students used the information and illustrations from the story to complete a character web.

Math - Students were introduced to different strategies to use when solving addition problems. Counting on, number lines and double facts were some of the strategies used to solve problems. Students also discovered that adding 1 to double facts is an easy way to solve problems.

Grammar- We identified how verbs are used with singular and plural nouns in a sentence. Students discovered that verbs that end in “ed” tell about the past.

Social Studies- Students gained an appreciation for our country’s history. We explored the life of Native Americans and pilgrims. Students recognized the challenges that each group faced. We discussed how Native Americans and pilgrims helped each other overcome these challenges.
