The students had a busy week reviewing skills and learning new concepts.

Our religion class time focused on the importance of God's creations. Students discussed different ways that we show thanks for all that God created. They understand that we are all special because God created each of us. We spent times discussing the importance of attending weekly Mass. We discussed how we should act at Mass.

During math we learned new vocabulary words. The words plus and equal were introduced and used in identifying parts of an addition sentence.

Our reading time focused on building stamina for independent reading. We discussed what our classroom looks like and sounds like when reading independently. The book *The Library Mouse* was used to introduce students to parts of a book. Students viewed a power point and completed an activity labeling parts of a book.

During social studies we discussed the importance of rules. We discussed rules at school, at home and in our community.
