The students just finished up studying the Constitutional Convention in class. They will have a quiz on the topic on Tuesday, 10/6. We discussed some good study strategies together:

- 1- Read the sections in the textbook again
- 2- Review my set of notes on Google Classroom
- 3- Review any notes they took in class

This topic leads us into our more in-depth study of the U.S. Constitution, which lays out the plan for our nation's government. At the end of the unit, the students will take a test on the United States Constitution. A passing grade is a requirement for graduation.

All handouts and study resources are located on the students' U.S. Constitution Google Classroom. We will review all of the important details in class together and discuss any questions they might have. The students will also work on pieces of the Study Guide as we go along so that they do not wait until the night before to complete the resource.

The U.S. Constitution Test is currently scheduled for Thursday, 10/22. Study strategies include completing and reviewing the study guide, re-reading all handouts, reviewing all questions on the handouts, creating flashcards, completing Quizlets or Kahoots, studying with a friend or family member, etc.
