Happy Friday 8th grade Families,

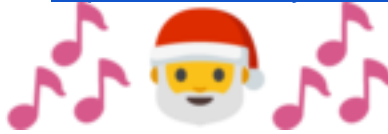
We have only a few reminders for this week.
