

## **Graduation Activities Information**

Hello 8th Grade Families,

Thank you for completing the survey about the graduation mass date. A large majority of families prefer to keep the date the same as it originally was planned so Graduation Mass will be **Saturday, May 29th at 10:00am** in the Church.

Attached you will find more information regarding the various activities related to graduation. As we draw closer to each event we will provide much more detailed information to the students and the families. And please know that some details may change along the way depending on the current circumstances and any updated guidelines from the Archdiocese.

Finally, regarding the Graduation Pictures on March 4th, Color Portraits normally bring a cap and gown with them so that the students can take those pictures along with their regular clothes pictures. This is also normally the picture that goes into the yearbook. However, we are concerned about students sharing the same cap and gown across all three cohorts. And unfortunately, we don't believe your individual caps and gowns we ordered for May Crowning/Graduation will be here in time.

Here are the options we can offer you.

1. Your child does not take a cap and gown picture.
2. Your child takes a cap and gown picture. We do have some extra caps and gowns in storage for those "just in case" moments. We can have one or two per cohort so that only students within the same cohort will be sharing the cap and gown.

You do not need to make a decision today. You and your child can talk it over and they can make the decision when they come to school the morning of graduation pictures.
