

## More Graduation Pictures Information

Hello 8th Grade Families,

We wanted to send out a few more details about **Graduation Pictures next Thursday, March 4th**.

1. Students should come to school that morning dressed in their nice outfits. They should be dressed up from head to toe. Although the pictures do not usually show their feet, we recommend the students wear dress shoes just in case.
2. Boys - It is up to you whether your son wears a full suit with the jacket or just a collared shirt with a tie for the pictures. Some have even worn a vest in the past. Please don't wear gym shoes or white socks with black dress shoes.
3. Girls - Yes, you can wear makeup and paint your nails for pictures. Please remember that if your dress is strapless or has spaghetti straps that you need to have some sort of cardigan or jacket over it. And all skirts must be of an appropriate length.
4. Students will change into their uniform right after they are done taking pictures so that their nice clothes do not get ruined. They can hang up their nice clothes in their locker for the day since the lockers are probably pretty empty otherwise.
5. The photographers will take both regular clothes pictures and cap & gown pictures (if chosen). We will have one or two sets of caps and gowns for each individual cohort to share. If you have a cap and gown from an older sibling your child can use that instead.
6. There is no order form for pictures ahead of time. After the pictures are taken, families will receive a copy of the proofs. From there you can decide which picture(s) and package(s) to order. You may even decide to not order and have your child retake their pictures.
7. We do not have a date set for retakes yet. We will only do so if a student is absent or chooses to complete retakes. Please know that there is usually a cost for retakes unless it is due to photographer error. Also, if you do retakes then those will be the pictures you have to choose from. You cannot go back to the original set of pictures to order.
