- COVID Procedures Eric Hoffman
 - Daughter in Pk-4 and two younger daughters SJS Alumni. Feels strongly about Covid Procedures, noted
 that the hyperlink for the minutes from the November meeting were not working. Can we be sure also
 post the group email for parents to use to contact.
 - o Curious about what "those in power" at SJS currently believe
 - o Does the Archdiocese reference what science they are using?
 - (Response from the Council) Yes, the CDC and the IDPH
 - Will masked snacking be coming to SJS?
 - (Response from the Council) No
 - o Will N95 be required at SJS?
 - (*Response from the Council*) Not to our knowledge
 - The band members with holes in their masks seems hypocritical
 - (Response from the Council) The band members are using masks and bell covers to remain safe while playing. The holes are designed so the instruments can fit through while also containing the other exhalations they produce while playing. The band wears regular masks when not playing.
 - o Will there be any questionnaire sent to school families regarding guidelines?
 - (*Response from the Council*) No because the school is bound to follow the guidelines of the Archdiocese and the State of Illinois.
 - What percentage of the student body has submitted their vaccine cards into the portal?
 - (Response from the Council) In the interest of guarding the privacy of all, we would rather not divulge an exact number; however, it is a very large number of students who are vaccinated ranging from K-8
 - (Response from the Council) Staff is 98% vaccinated
 - o Will there be masking in the 22/23 school year?
 - (Response from the Council) Archdiocese has not thought that far out.
 - Can a meeting be requested to have a representative from the Archdiocese come to SJS to hear from parents?
 - (Response from the Council) Yes, Principal Kendrick will email and make that request.
 - o Will the restaurants for Daddy/Daughter be checking vaccine cards?
 - (Response from the Council) Will need to contact the restaurant directly to find out the policy
