 - A. Principal Report Dr. Mike Kendrick
 - 1. End of 2nd Trimester is Friday, March 3, 2023
 - 2. IReady Scores coming next week
 - a) IReady scores show great growth and staff is happy with progress, Fall and Winter reports will go out to parents early next week
 - 3. Registration is going well with 572 students currently registered, an increase from our current 553 students
 - a) Waitlist for Prek4
 - b) Close to waitlist for PreK3, Kindergarten (with 4 classrooms) and 2nd Grade
 - 4. O'Brien Room will be renovated into a state of the art gross motor Prek and Kindergarten Center
 - a) Plans are solidified and are out for bid, ideally work would start before the end of the school year

- 1. Mass attendance is taken regularly, last week we were at 2,700, which is about 40 short of pre-covid numbers, love seeing young families
- 2. Be on the lookout for digital evangelization efforts from Mark J via Facebook/Instagram/Google
- 3. We are in the initial stages of replacing exterior windows on the North side of the church
- 4. The Archdiocese is working on additional building repairs for Renew my Parish totaling approximately \$2.2 million
